# Postoperative “Surprises”

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- “I didn’t realize the reading vision would be this bad”
- “How come I can’t see anything up close”
- “I wish you had talked me into a multifocal”
- “My reading vision is so much worse!”
  
- What problems do you see with monofocal IOLs postoperatively?
- What patients tend to notice this the most?
  - Younger, low myopes, patients with early myopic shift?
- What problems do you see with bifocals/progressives
  - Talk to opticians about bifocals

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- What Is the role of a Toric monofocal?
  - If patient wants better uncorrected vision to correct astigmatism wouldn't they be better off with at least a Toric EDOF IOL than a true Toric monofocal?
  - Won't patient satisfaction be higher with a Toric EDOF than a Toric monofocal
  - What would happen to your practice numbers if 20% of your Toric monofocal patients elected to have a Toric EDOF?
